We are writing to inform you that ASi intends to withdraw support for older versions of PKZIP UNIX with effect from May 31<sup>st</sup>, 1999. Please see page two for specific version information. We are giving you six months notice, in line with our software license agreement.

We are making these changes to ensure all our customers are utilizing the latest and best technology. After May 31<sup>st</sup>, 1999 all PKZIP UNIX supported products will be year 2000 compliant. Other product enhancements include the ability to add a password to a UNIX self-extracting file and a number of maintenance fixes.

Customers wanting continued support after this date will be required to have a Year 2000 compliant version of PKZIP.
